"I fell for an IRS scam. I did not think I owed taxes but I was scared. I knew better but I paid the scammer anyways."

This is what one of the older adults said when we presented at their facility. We have similar heartbreaking stories at each of our presentations. Stories from older adults or family/friends on scams that have a devastating effect.

R.O.S.E. was founded by Joyce Petrowski who recognized a need in the community based on a personal experience with a loved one. She realized that the older adults are often targets of criminals because of their philanthropic and trusting nature. Joyce is a non-profit entrepreneur as she co-founded a successful non-profit in 2014 and R.O.S.E. is the second non-profit she founded in 2021.

R.O.S.E. has an engaged, experienced, and financially committed Board of Directors with the mission to prevent the financial exploitation and defrauding of the older adults through advocacy and education.

Over the past few years, Arizona has ranked in the top ten in the United States for reported financial losses with the older adult population from financial frauds and scams. In 2022, Arizona's older adult population reported losses of over \$82 million. This amount has drastically increased from \$54 million in 2021 and \$27 million in 2020.

R.O.S.E.'s vision - retirement should be the best years of your life; it should be protected at all costs.

The older adult population are looking to retire if not already retired. Their retirement should be a time for enjoyment and living their life with the retirement funds they have saved through their hard work.

R.O.S.E. launched our program in Arizona and through careful consideration of our operational capacity, our long-term goal is to establish a trusted brand and operational capacity to expand our operations throughout the United States.

R.O.S.E. is one of the leading forces in delivering effective, concise, and face-to-face awareness and prevention program to the older adults (and their families) so that they will be aware of the types of scams that are prevalent and dangerous to this population and what they can do to help prevent being affected.



R.O.S.E. is creating change by providing awareness of financial scams that typically target the older adult population. We have seen a drastic increase in the monetary loss due to the financial scams and our goal is not only to reduce the amount of losses, also the number of older adults affected.

Through thoughtful content creation and impassioned speakers, R.O.S.E. helps to protect our vulnerable older adults and their hard-earned assets. R.O.S.E. engages with local, regional, and national experts in financial crime and cybersecurity. This will help R.O.S.E. to continuously evaluate and update the program with current, relevant content.

Our program is designed to be recurring with a minimum of 2 presentations at the same community per year. This design will assist the older adults to continue to be aware of the frauds, prevention tools, and continue the conversation with their friends and family. This will help the older adults keep the information top of mind because it is not a matter of "if" they will be contacted, it is a matter of "when' and "how often" they will be contacted.

Our purpose, team and content have allowed us to have immediate success with fundraising through year-end appeal, Arizona Gives Day, events, and grants.

R.O.S.E. has created a sponsorship program (see separate sponsorship levels pdf) to engage the community to help build our operational capacity to increase the reach of our valuable program throughout Arizona.

To date, R.O.S.E has presented to over 500 older adults, and we have only begun. Arizona ranks in the top 10 with one of the largest older adult communities.
