Evil Twin Wi-Fi Attack! Say What?



What is an evil twin Wi-Fi attack? Evil twin hotspot...wireless network that impersonates a legitimate one by copying it's name or SSID. When multiple networks have the same name, your device will often connect with the stronger signal which can be the scammer's network.

In Australia, the police arrested an airline passenger for running a malicious Wi-Fi network in the airport and on the plane. The scammer carried a portable hotspot onto the plane and named it with the same name as the airline's official Wi-Fi network.

Traveling is a prime target as mobile data can be expensive, and limited choices brings many travelers to Wi-Fi networks.

How can you stay safe?

Have strong anti-virus, anti-malware on all of your devices.

Turn off automatic Wi-Fi connections

Limit what you access at the airport and during the flight



Federal prosecutors have indicted the founder and leaders of the House of Prayer Christian Churches of America, accusing them of running a decades-long \$22 million fraud scheme targeting U.S. military members and veterans.

The indictment details allegations of bank and wire fraud, misuse of VA education benefits, false tax returns, and coercive control of members' finances and property. FBI officials state: "Exploiting trust, faith, and the service of our nation's military members to enrich themselves will not shield wrongdoers from accountability."

Veteran Giveback Program 2025

You may be eligible for up to **\$174 per month back** on the Part B **Veteran Giveback Program**, that's up to **\$2,088 per year back to your Social Security check**. Every month you'll get a credit to your Social Security check. Extra benefits include Dental, Vision, and Hearing all at no cost outside of the VA. Benefits are administered through Medicare Part C. Spouses of Veterans may also qualify if they have CHAMPVA or TRICARE for Life.

It is preferred to call within 5 days to help us manage our call volume.

The Federal Communications Commission announced it has blocked more than 1,200 voice service providers from having access to the country's phone network for failing to comply with anti-robocall regulations, marking the agency's largest enforcement action against companies that facilitate illegal automated calls.
